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WORK COMPLETED:

- Determined the approach to collect information on interchange/intersection plow routes;
- Completed one plow route example for cloverleaf interchange with C/D lanes; and
- Uploaded the enlarged and high resolution plow route example plot and the 10 intersection/interchange configuration plots to a web site to be referred by the survey respondents.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES EXPECTED TO BE PERFORMED NEXT QUARTER:

- Complete the plow route examples for the remaining 9 intersection/interchange configurations;
- Circulate the survey questionnaire and gather all the related information;
- Summarize the survey results and identify the best practices;
- Refine the training video outline and develop the scripts; and
- Start developing the training video.
