Guidance is being sought from committee members and others regarding potential survey recipients/respondents.

Task 6 (Recommendations) has exceeded budget due to the unforeseen need to obtain additional information. Overall budget is not expected to be affected.

MnDOT District 4 has been identified as a partner for Task 8 (Pilot Deployment). Completion of Task 8 requires winter conditions. Due to the initial difficulties in identifying a project partner and scope, completion of the pilot deployment is delayed until Winter 2020-21.
